## Store Made Gifts

## Medium Candy Bouquet

## Colors

Plan your candy bouquet first. Choose coordinating balloon, bows, curling ribbon, shred and candy.

## Filler

Neatly arrange candy in a medium mason jar by lining candy around edges of jar. Use shred as a space filler.

## Candy Connector

Use the candy box dot to attach the candy connector to the center of the lid.

## Curling Ribbon

Tie 2 or 3 strands of curling ribbon in a double knot around the candy connector and curl the ribbon. Repeat with 2-3 more ribbon strands (grouping them allows you to easily spread them around the jar).

## Bow

Staple the bow backing cards together to form a tunnel for the candy connector; then fluff the bows. Slide onto the candy connector.

## Balloon

Slide the mini balloon onto the candy connector and push down to secure.
