Assemble the balloon display tower, fill the base with water and extend the pole to five feet.

Air-inflate the main foil balloon. Slide the tail through one of the holes on the balloon cup that came with the tower and secure it with clear tape. Set aside.

#11685 | #11633

Air-inflate two black latex balloons to 11" and tie together to form a duplet. Repeat to create a second duplet. Twist the two duplets together to create a four-balloon cluster.

Create a second cluster using HiGloss® purple latex balloons, inflated to 7". Nest clusters together, wrap an uninflated 260 around the clusters to hold them together and tie off.

Slide the 8 balloon cluster down the pole of the balloon tower to cover the water base.

Air-inflate the number balloons. Wrap curling ribbon around the portion that will be covered by pearls to secure them to the metal pole.

#87233 | #11192

Helium inflate the standard foil balloons and remaining latex balloons, add curling ribbon and set them aside.

Blue 260 Balloon Pearls

Stretch each 260 to make them easier to work with. Air-inflate each 260 leaving 10" uninflated at the end.

Hold the knot end of the with one hand. This hand will hold the completed pearls, not twist them.

With your other hand, pinch the 260 about 1" to 1.5" from the knot and twist it 5 to 7 times to create the first "pearl".

While maintaining your hold on the first pearl with your non-twisting hand, use your twisting hand to pinch the next section.

ALWAYS twist in the same direction to prevent the pearls from unraveling!

Twist the same number of times for each pearl.

Continue pinching and twisting pearls of uniform size along the length of the 260.

Once you have enough pearls, secure the strand by wrapping it around the number balloons and tie the end to either the knot or the first pearl you made. Trim off any excess.

Purple 260 Firework Explosion

Fully air-inflate each 260, pinch and hold the last 2-3 inches and let the rest deflate.

While still holding the inflated portion, re-inflate the 260 to the desired length. You can now let go and tie off the end. Repeat this process six more times.

Tie the ends of the seven 260s together to make the explosion. Slip the explosion through the 8 balloon cluster latex base and adjust them so they are shooting upward along the back of the display.

Attached the primary foil balloon to the top of the balloon tower. Add the standard foils and the four latex balloons into the base, adjusting and tying them at your desired the float height.
