## Primary Balloon

Inflate the 11" latex balloon. Tie the neck.

When using air to inflate the primary balloon, omit the heavy weight. Instead tie curling ribbon to the upper 260 and hang the design.

Lips
Air inflate two 260s leaving $2^{\prime \prime}$ uninflated at the tip. Tie the 260 s together at the neck. One 260 at a time, twist off a 4" segment just below the neck. Bend the segment in half and twist to form a golf ball sized lip. Repeat to create the other lip. Twist the lips together. Wrap the neck of the 11 " latex through the lips to attach them.

## Fins

Wrap the 260s snugly around the 11 " latex and twist them at the top to hold them in place. Tie the uninflated tips together to form a ring. Squeeze the ring in half to make two loops. Keep the knot in the middle and twist the loops around each other to make the fins. Tie curling ribbon to the lower 260 and add a weight.

## Eyes

Air inflate a $5^{\prime \prime}$ latex balloon to the size of a small apple. Tie the knot as close to the end of the neck as possible. Using your thumb, squeeze the knot into the center of the balloon and twist it in half to make two equal parts. Slip the balloon under the upper 260. Add eyes with a
permanent marker.



## Save helium!

Fill the primary balloon with air. Hang it using an adhesive tab and curling ribbon.
No weight needed!
