

FISH HOOK COLLAR



Build Time 5 minutes

1	5101	5" Standard Latex Assortment (4 needed)
1	18302	260 Classic Twistee Assortment (3 needed)
1	1123	3/16" Red Curling Ribbon
1	1598	Heavy Weight
1	721093	Balloon Bond

Primary Balloon

Inflate the primary balloon, tie with curling ribbon and attach weight.

When using air to inflate the primary balloon, omit the heavy weight. Instead attach a hang tab to the top of the balloon and hang it with curling ribbon or monofilament.

5" Latex Collar

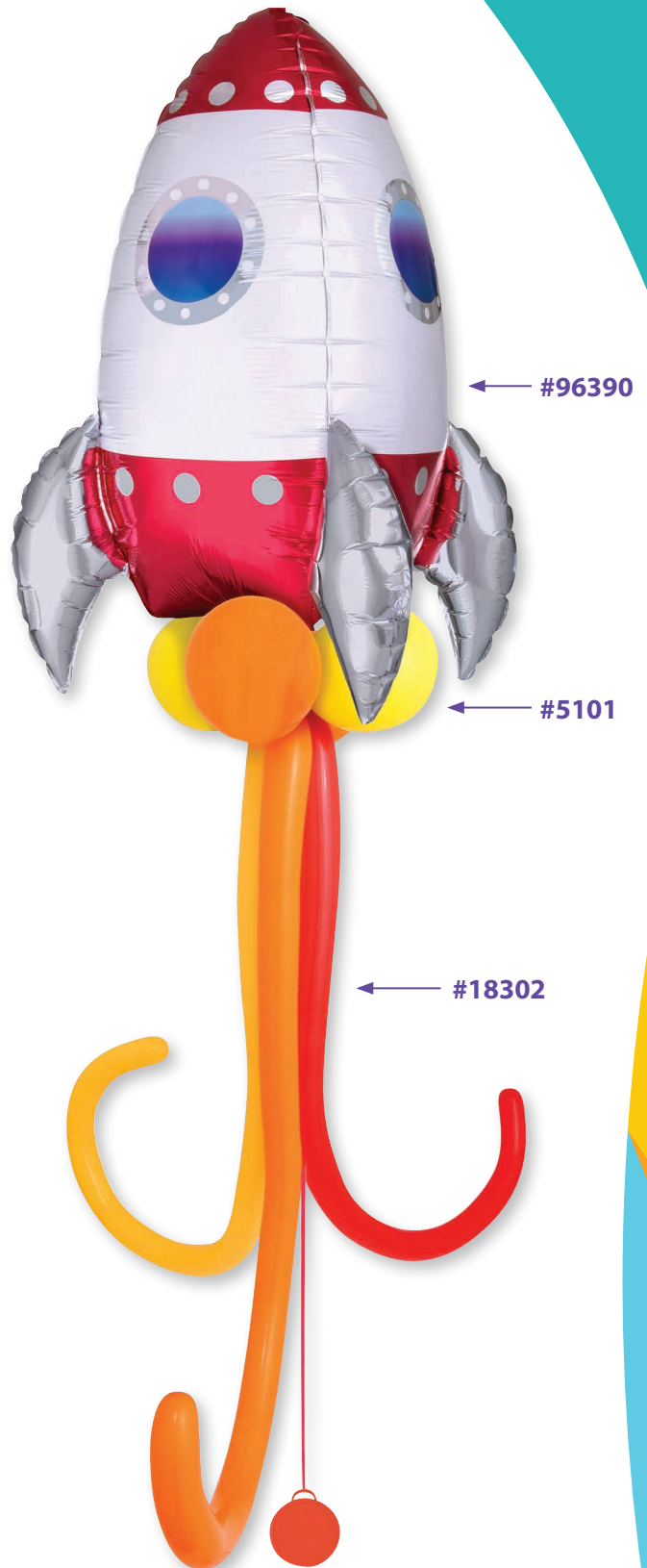
Air inflate two 5" balloons and tie them together to form a duplet. Repeat to create a second duplet. Twist the two duplets together to create a four-balloon cluster. Place the cluster under the helium filled balloon and twist the balloons around the tail. Push up on the cluster to secure it as closely to the bottom of the balloon as possible.

260 Latex Balloons

Fully air inflate a 260, then release a tiny bit of air to make it more pliable. Tie the neck. Repeat to create two additional 260s. Tie the 260s together at the necks. Slip them through the 5" balloon cluster and pull them down so they are locked in place under the cluster as shown. Shape each 260 by hand to create a tight curve at the lower end. Hide the weighted curling ribbon in the center of the 260s. Use balloon bond to adhere the 260s together approximately 18" below the latex cluster.



WARNING: Children under 8 years can choke or suffocate on uninflated or broken balloons. Adult supervision required. Keep uninflated balloons from children. Discard broken balloons at once.



Defy Gravity!

Save helium!

Fill the primary balloon with air. Hang it using an adhesive tab and curling ribbon. No weight needed!
