Air inflate two black latex balloons to 3" and tie together to form a duplet. Repeat to create a second duplet. Twist the two duplets together to create a four-balloon cluster. Set aside. Repeat the steps to build 3 more black clusters and 2 red clusters.

Repeat the step to create one black and one red cluster inflated to 5". Set aside.

Using the same steps above build one more cluster inflated to 9".

Helium inflate the ladybug foil balloons. Tie an uninflated 260 to the tail of each balloon below

## **Building The Column**

Start from the bottom and work your way up. Nest the 5" black cluster into the 9" cluster. Nest the 5" red cluster next. Secure the first ladybug to the clusters by wrapping the uninflated 260 several times through the center. Tie the 260 to the bouquet weight to add stability to the column.

Attach two adhesive hang tabs, back-to-back, on the top of the ladybug balloon between the antennas. Make sure the holes in the tabs line up.

Repeat the steps above using the 3" latex clusters under the second ladybug. Tie the uninflated 260 to the hang tabs on the top of the first ladybug. Tie the 260 so that no gap is visible between the latex and the foil balloon (You will have to bend the antenna over). Add hang tabs to the

Follow the same steps for the final ladybug.
