Helium inflate balloons and attach curling ribbon.
\#97461
Air inflate. Roll the tail tightly around the middle of an uninflated 260 . Tie the 260 in a knot to secure it to the balloon.

## \#12526 - Latex Clusters

Air inflate two 11" latex balloons to 10 " and tie them together to form a duplet. Repeat to create a second duplet. Twist the two duplets together to create a four-balloon cluster.

Repeat steps to create a second cluster inflated to 7 ".
Nest the foil pumpkin balloon on the 10" cluster. Slip the ends of the uninflated 260 through the cluster and
tie to secure it in place. Use an additional uninflated 260 to attach the bouquet weight beneath the cluster.

Slip the stem of the foil pumpkin balloon through the middle of the 7" cluster to seat it on top of the balloon. Reinforce the hang tab on the stem with clear tape. Use a hole punch to reopen the hole in the tab. Slip the curling ribbon of each helium filled balloon through the tab. Adjust each balloon to the desired height \& tie them in place. Curl the excess ribbon.

## Adding the Spider

Hang the spider between the two pieces of curling ribbon and secure. See next page for instructions to build the spider.

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## \#5402 / \#18261

Eyes: Inflate two 5" white latex balloons to 2". Tie together to make a duplet. Add pupils with a Sharpie ${ }^{\oplus}$ marker.
Body: Inflate a 11" black latex to 7".
Inflate a black 260 leaving 6-8" uninflated.
Tie the necks of the 7" latex and the 260 together.
Starting from the bottom of the 260 and working towards the end:

- Make two pinch twists (see below).
- Make two 5" links. Wrap the eye duplet between the 2 links. Fold over and twist the second link into the initial pinch twists.
- Make two additional 5" links. Fold over and twist the second link into the initial pinch twists.
- Tie off and remove any remaining uninflated 260 .

Legs: Inflate 8 black 260s to the lengths below leaving the rest uninflated. Tie the neck so there is an inch extra to secure the leg to the body. Tie off the uninflated portion tightly and remove the extra.

- Make four 6" legs.
- Make four 8" legs.
- Add one set of 8 " legs through the pinch twists, wrapping the long neck around several times to secure them.

Add the remaining legs through the 5 " body links (the 6 " legs are closer to the eyes). To do this, pull the long neck through one side of the body, tie it to the other leg and pull the knot back inside the body to hide it.

Slightly bend the legs to finish the spider.

## How to Make a Pinch Twist

Twist a 1.5" link. Twist the two ends of the same link together. This will make the link into a sphere.
Pulling up slightly while twisting will make the twist easier.
